EN 581-2:2026 includes the following significant technical changes with respect to EN 581-2:2015:

- c) updated seating requirements for stability to take into account new edition of EN 1022:2023;
- d) updated requirements for seating and clarification of the application of certain tests with footnote to tables;
- e) Annex A (normative) “Test method for deckchair” has been added;
- f) Annex B (informative) “Test method for folding lounge” has been added;
- g) Annex C (informative) “Guide to facilitate the identification of deckchairs” has been added;
- h) Annex D (informative) “Purchase information (guidelines)” has replaced Annex B;
- i) Annex A “Forward and sideways stability tests for loungers” has been deleted;
- j) clarification of the instruction for use;

## 1 Scope

This document specifies the minimum requirements for general safety and structural safety which include strength, reliability and stability of all types of outdoor seating for camping use, for domestic use and for contract use, for adults, without regard to materials, design or manufacturing processes.

It does not apply to street furniture.

It does not include requirements for removable upholstery, including the cover and filling.

It does not include requirements for the durability of castors/wheels and height adjustment mechanisms.

It does not include requirements for electrical safety.

It does not include requirements for the resistance to ageing and degradation caused by light, temperature and moisture.

The test requirements contained within this document are based on use by persons weighing up to 110 kg.

### 3.1

#### **seating for camping use**

seating for outdoor light in weight, intended for occasional use in connection with camping and travelling and can be easily reduced in volume for transporting and storing

Note 1 to entry: Such products are often foldable or knock-down.

### 3.2

#### **seating for domestic use**

outdoor seating intended for private use in places without public access

Note 1 to entry: Such products can be foldable or knock-down.
