

## Paper and board — Determination of water absorptiveness — Cobb method

## 1 Scope

This document specifies a method for determining the water absorptiveness of paper and board, including corrugated fibreboard, under standard conditions.

This document is not applicable for paper of grammage less than  $50 \text{ g/m}^2$  or embossed paper. It is not applicable for porous papers such as newsprint or papers such as blotting paper or other papers having a relatively high-water absorptiveness for which ISO 8787 is more suitable.
