Introduction

The moisture-holding capacity indicates the rank of hard coals and is used in coal classification for correcting the calorific value of the sample to the moist mineral matter-free basis. The full moisture-holding capacity is that of the coal in equilibrium with an atmosphere saturated with water vapour. Since there are impossible to overcome experimental difficulties in working with such an atmosphere, the determination is carried out at 96% to 97% relative humidity.
