Introduction

The X-ray centrifuge monitors particle concentration changes at a fixed or variable radius. In some configurations, the instrument can also be used in a gravitational mode (see ISO 13317-1) and those data blended with other data determined in the centrifugal mode, thus extending the typical upper size limit above $5 \, \mu m$.
