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This document was prepared by Technical Committee ISO/TC 96, *Cranes*, Subcommittee SC 6, *Mobile cranes*.

This third edition cancels and replaces the second edition (ISO 7752-2:2011), which has been technically revised.

The main changes are as follows:

- introduction of the telescoping fly jib;
- introduction of the luffing fly jib with the bi-directional levers.

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Mobile crane operators frequently transfer from one crane to another of different model or manufacturer. This document establishes a consistent arrangement and movement for the basic controls used during the crane-operating cycle, to reduce operator confusion or incorrect control in an emergency. Some cranes may not be equipped with all functions shown in the figures of this document.
