Section 1 GENERAL

1.1 SCOPE

This standard covers polyvinyl chloride (PVC) fittings intended to be joined in the field by means of a solvent cement system to PVC rigid conduit, tubing, and other fittings, based on the outside diameters given in NEMA TC 2-2013.

Included in this publication are requirements for materials, workmanship, dimensions, physical properties, couplings, female adapters, male terminals, junction box adapters, reducers, elbows, caps, and end-bells. Methods of marking, inspection, and practices for indicating compliance with these standards are also given. Junction boxes and access fittings are not included.

NOTE—The values stated in U.S. Customary Units are to be regarded as the standard. Metric units are provided for information.
